Dr. Ghassan Al-Naami voluntarily withdraws from practice

Edmonton, AB – Edmonton pediatrician Dr. Ghassan Al-Naami has voluntarily withdrawn from practice after being served with an undertaking from the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA). Dr. Al-Naami was charged with possession and transmission of child pornography on August 11, 2019.
