

The College of Physicians & Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA) operates under the authority of the *Health Professions Act* and applicable regulations and bylaws.

CPSA's governing Council includes physician members, public members and representatives from Alberta's medical schools. Physician members are elected annually by Alberta doctors, while public members and medical school representatives are appointed. CPSA's team consists of approximately 155 people who are mainly located in Edmonton. The Chief Executive Officer, who carries the title Registrar, is Dr. Scott McLeod.
