Note 1: Starting in 2018, the net results of the accreditation program are internally restricted to be used for the accreditation department for future development costs.

Note 2: In 2022 there will be an allocation of \$4,248,000 from the Building Fund to the unrestricted surplus on the Statement of Changes in Net Assets. This allocation facilitates a one-time reduction in physician annual fees from \$2,150 to \$1,792.
