

Everything to know for your visit to CPSA

Where we're located

• Our office is on the 27th and 28th floors of <u>TELUS House</u> (10020 – 100 Street NW) in downtown Edmonton. TELUS House is located behind ATB Place on the south side of ATB Plaza.

Getting here

- Paid public parking is available in several nearby lots, the closest being underground at ATB Place or the surface lot behind MacEwan's Alberta College campus.
- Central Station is the closest LRT station, which you can access through the pedway system off concourse level of our building.

Before you attend your meeting

- Approximately 24 hours before your meeting, you'll receive an email with a pre-registration questionnaire that will ask you to provide details about yourself.
- Once you complete the questionnaire, you'll receive a QR code via email.

When you arrive

- When you arrive at TELUS House, please visit the Triovest Security desk in the building's lobby.
- Use the middle bank of elevators to go to the 27th floor and go to the Reception desk to sign in at the iPad using your QR code or to complete your questionnaire if you didn't complete it in advance.
- Your meeting host will be notified of your arrival and come greet you in CPSA's lobby.
- Please help yourself to the self-serve coffee/beverage bars outside our meeting rooms. Help us keep our office tidy by placing dirty dishes in the bins located in the coffee bars.

Before you leave

- After your meeting, please return your visitor pass to your meeting organizer.
- If you are leaving after hours, place the visitor pass in the "after hours drop off" slot located on the right side of the Reception desk (nearest to the hallway).

In case of emergency

- If an alarm sounds, check in with your meeting organizer/department contact immediately and collect all your personal belongings (coat, purse/bag, etc.).
- If the standby tone (slow, repetitive single beeps) goes off, exit the office space immediately and meet in CPSA's elevator lobbies on the 27th or 28th floors to await further instructions. You will either hear an announcement to evacuate the building or the all-clear will be given, at which point you can return to your meeting.
- If the evacuation tone (fast, continuous beeps) sounds, proceed to the nearest stairwell and evacuate to CPSA's muster point: Scotia Square Dentistry on the main floor of Rice Howard Place.
 - Please do not take beverages into the stairwell when evacuating or attempt to retrieve your vehicle from the parkade.
- Once you have reached the muster point, locate your meeting organizer/department contact and let them know you have safely evacuated the building. Await the all-clear announcement, at which point you can return to CPSA's offices.
