RE:	Urinalysis Reagent Shortage: Limited Availability of Laboratory Urinalysis Testing

## PLEASE POST OR DISTRIBUTE AS WIDELY AS APPROPRIATE

## **Key Message**

- Constrained supply levels of urinalysis reagent used across Canada are now impacting community / outpatient testing throughout Alberta.
  - Scope of this issue has expanded from the select settings listed in the July 15, 2022 bulletin.
- Due to critically low supply, utilization controls are necessary for the foreseeable future.
- Only order laboratory urinalysis testing that is required for urgent management of the patient.
- Requests for routine urinalysis will not be performed. Patients may be asked to return at a later date for these collections, where possible.
- When supply levels stabilize (date unknown), additional communication will be released.

### **Background**

- The main supplier of laboratory urinalysis reagent used in Alberta has indicated on-going product shortages nationally; resolution of the shortage is unknown at this time.
- Updates will be provided when the supply issues stabilize.

#### **Action Required**

- Limit laboratory urinalysis ordering for only <u>urgent</u> management of the patient.
- Please indicate "Urgent" on the requisition.
- Please postpone routine urinalysis testing that is for health monitoring, where clinically acceptable.
