<p>How will sustainability be assessed for the project (i.e., evidence of future funding once the project is implemented or in other ways?)</p>	<p>The submission should include how the project/initiative or its impact can be sustained locally beyond the grant period.</p> <p>Identifying other sources of funding that have been obtained or plans to obtain additional funding could be one way to show sustainability.</p>
<p>Can the benefit to Albertans target a specific subset and/or geographical area of the provincial population?</p>	<p>Yes, the benefit to Albertans may apply to a target group of Albertans.</p>
<p>Who is on the grant review panel?</p>	<p>The role representation is included in <a href="#">The Terms of Reference for the Building Fund Initiatives Working Group</a>, but the specific individuals are not provided to protect their privacy.</p>
<p>Are you able to tell us how many expressions of intent you received?</p>	<p>CPSA has received a total of 279 Expression of Intent Submissions. We are unable to disclose other applicants until the recipients of the grant have been selected.</p>
