

Quick tips & tricks for your Council candidate photo



Angles

Your photo-taking device should be roughly eye level—if possible, have someone take the photo for you



Light source

Your light source should be in front of you, not behind you, to ensure your face is properly illuminated



Glasses

If wearing glasses, consider the way the light reflects off of them to avoid obstructing your eyes



Framing

Ensure your photo captures your full face—try to include your shoulders up to the top of your head with some space around you
